S3 W3 & Environmental Education

The Eco-Friendly Forest (S3) is continually growing from the ground up as people work together to plant seedlings. The waterfront and paddy fields of the

hilside are used to hold educational events, including nature observation activities and chances to try farming. The Forest Pond (W3) is surrounded by a Japanese black pine forest, grasslands and sandy areas, which are home to a diverse range of plants and animals.




Park Rules

- areas. Open flames including campfires and fireworks


