### 15 Wonder World

Cost: 100 to 600 yen

There are plenty of fun attractions like go-karts and mini steam engines. There is also a food court named Wonder Shuttle (Restaurant) nearby.

### G3 Sunshine Pool

(Summer season only)

Popular attractions include the tube-shaped Dragon Slider waterslide, as well as 6 unique pools including a flowing pool and a Water Jungle with universal design aspects which everyone can enjoy!

### C4 Forest House

(Closed: Jun & Nov to Feb)

Enjoy crafting with natural materials like pine cones and acorns.  
\*Children under 4th grade of elementary must be accompanied by a guardian.

### Q3 Dog Run

At this dog run, dogs can play without a leash. (\*Fees apply) **It is required by law to have a dog license and proof of rabies vaccination to enter.**

\*Diapers not permitted, change of clothes necessary.

### R4 Light and Wind Ground

You can enjoy accommodation, cafés, and athletic equipment (fees apply) and get a taste of what staying in a nature park is like. Embrace this area's themes of "relaxing," "learning," and "playing."

### S3 W3 Nature Experience & Environmental Education

The Eco-Friendly Forest (S3) is continually growing from the ground up as people work together to plant seedlings. The waterfront and paddy fields of the hillside are used to hold educational events, including nature observation activities and chances to try farming. The Forest Pond (W3) is surrounded by a Japanese black pine forest, grasslands and sandy areas, which are home to a diverse range of plants and animals.

\*Bicycles can be rented until one hour before park closing. \*Bicycles must only be ridden on the cycling course. \*Please park bicycles only in designated bicycle parking areas. \*If you are the holder of a physical disabilities certificate, disabilities certificate, or mental health disabilities certificate, please show your certificate and you (as well as one accompanying person) can receive a 50% discount on rentals. \*3-Hour Passes are available for purchase from March to May, as well as from September to October. The Day Pass is purchasable from June to August, as well as from November to February. \*The fee for tandem and electric assisted bikes is the same for both children and adults. \*An insurance fee of 1000 yen is required for the electric assisted bikes.

\*Electric kick scooters can be rented until one hour before park closing. \*Electric kick scooters can be rented at Uminonakamichi Station Gate, the Light and Wind Ground Gate, and the Port Cycling Station. The fee for the Port Cycling Station includes the admission fee for the park. Rental requires a smartphone with a camera and the app installed. \*Kick scooters must only be used on the cycling course. \*Recommended for people aged 13 and over. The rider must be over 140cm in height to use this service.

### Park Rules

- Smoking is only allowed in designated smoking areas.
- Open flames including campfires and fireworks are prohibited.
- If you bring a pet, please keep it on a leash or in a cage, and be sure to clean up after it.
- In addition, pets are not allowed in the Animal Forest and indoor facilities such as restaurants.
- Please take all of your trash home with you when you leave.

### Prohibited Items

Baseball bats (wooden or metal), balls (soft, hard or rubber balls), golf equipment, skateboards/kickboards (or related items), radio-controlled toys or drones.

Some of the nursing rooms in the park are designated as "Baby Stations" by Fukuoka City.

- Baby changing tables, baby chairs and nursing rooms are located near main facilities.
- Feel free to ask for hot water (to warm formula) at management centers and shops.
- Free baby strollers are available at all gates.

**Yellow Triangle Flags**

We have placed yellow triangle flags in areas that are 7m or higher above sea level, including the Animal Forest Observation Deck (E4), West Gate Management Building (G7), Children's Playground (H5), Outdoor Theater (I3) and Eco-friendly Forest Observation Deck (T3). We are gradually placing them in other locations as well. Please use these flags as both a landmark and a tsunami evacuation point.
