Flowering times may change depending on weather conditions and other factors. The Flower Museum has a collection of seasonal flowers in bloom throughout the year.





nature observation activities and chances to try farming. The Forest Pond (W3) is surrounded by a Japanese black pine forest, grasslands and sandy areas, which are home to a diverse range of plants and animals.


