*Groups must have 20 or more visitors who are elementary-school aged or above.
*After admission, you are allowed to enter and leave the park freely only on the day of your visit.
To re-enter the park, you will need your admission ticket for that day.
*Seniors must present proof of age (such as a driver's license, etc.) to get the Senior Rate.

Strollers, wheelchairs, mobility scooters (electric carts).
*Mobility scooters (electric carts) are available for individuals with physical disabilities (which make walking difficult) who have a disability certificate.

*An insurance fee of 1000 yen is required for the electric assisted bikes.

*Rental requires a smartphone with a camera and the app installed. *Kick scooters must only be used on the cycling course.
*The rider must be over 145cm in height to use this service. Recommended for people aged 13 and over.

Park Rules


- Smoking is only allowed in designated smoking areas.
- Open flames including campfires and fireworks are prohibited.
- If you bring a pet, please keep it on a leash or in a cage, and be sure to clean up after it.
- In addition, pets are not allowed in the Animal Forest and indoor facilities such as restaurants.
- Please take all of your trash home with you when you leave.

Prohibited Items

Baseball bats (wooden or metal), balls (soft, hard or rubber balls), golf equipment, skateboards/kickboards (or related items), radio-controlled toys or drones.

- Free baby strollers are available at all gates.

■ **Yellow Triangle Flags**
We have placed yellow triangle flags in areas that are 7m or higher above sea level, including the Animal Forest Observation Deck (E4), West Gate Management Building (G7), Children's Playground (H5), Outdoor Theater (B3) and Eco-Friendly Forest Observation Deck (T3). We are gradually placing them in other locations as well. Please use these flags as both a landmark and a tsunami evacuation point.
