Nature Experience & Environmental Education

The Eco-Friendly Forest (S3) is continually growing from the ground up as people work together to plant seedlings. The waterfront and paddy fields of the hillside are used to hold educational events, including nature observation activities and chances to try farming. The Forest Pond (W3) is surrounded by a Japanese black pine forest, grasslands and sandy areas, which are home to a diverse range of plants and animals.

If you bring a pet, please keep it on a leash or in a cage, and be sure to clean up after it.
In addition, pets are not allowed in the Animal

Forest and indoor facilities such as restaurants.

Please take all of your trash home with you when you leave.


Prohibited Items


