- F4 Animal Museum Shop (Inside the Animal Forest Rest House)**: Here you'll find a wide selection of original merchandise featuring adorable animals. They also have soft-serve ice cream and coffee. *Days of operation vary depending on the season.
- K5 Soft-Serve Ice Cream Shop (Marine World Parking Lot)**: This shop offers honey donuts and soft-serve ice cream, depending on the season. *Days of operation vary depending on the season.
- R4 INN THE PARK FUKUOKA Café**: Serving drinks and desserts on weekdays and Japanese style curry and sandwiches on weekends and holidays.

E3 Animal Forest

A mini, natural wildlife park where you can interact with the animals. In this relaxed environment you can enjoy some 500 animals of about 50 different species, including capybaras, kangaroos, Bolivian squirrel monkeys, and flamingos.

Feeding: Enjoy feeding goats, sheep, and waterfowl.

Petting Animal Farm: Try petting a guinea pig while it sits on your lap.

- Light and Wind Ground** (You can enjoy accommodation, cafes, and athletic equipment (fees apply) and get a taste of what staying in a nature park is like. Embrace this area's themes of "relaxing," "learning," and "playing.")
- Nature Experience & Environmental Education** (The Eco-Friendly Forest (S3) is continually growing from the ground up as people work together to plant seedlings. The waterfront and paddy fields of the hillside are used to hold educational events, including nature observation activities and chances to try farming. The Forest Pond (W3) is surrounded by a Japanese black pine forest, grasslands and sandy areas, which are home to a diverse range of plants and animals.)

G3 Sunshine Pool (Summer season only): Popular attractions include the tube-shaped Dragon Slider waterslide, as well as 6 unique pools including a floating pool and a Water Jungle with universal design aspects which everyone can enjoy!

C4 Forest House: Enjoy crafting with natural materials like pine cones and acorns. *Children under 4th grade of elementary must be accompanied by a guardian.

Park Rules

- Smoking is only allowed in designated smoking areas.
- Open flames including campfires and fireworks are prohibited.
- If you bring a pet, please keep it on a leash or in a cage, and be sure to clean up after it. In addition, pets are not allowed in the Animal Forest and indoor facilities such as restaurants.
- Please take all of your trash home with you when you leave.

Prohibited Items: Baseball bats (wooden or metal), balls (soft, hard or rubber balls), golf equipment, skateboards/kickboards (or related items), radio-controlled toys or drones.

Transportation Information

We kindly ask that you please use public transportation or avoid visiting at peak times whenever possible.

Train: 5 min. via Airport Line, 11 min. via Kogoshima Line, 18 min. via Nishitetsu Kaizuka Line, 12 min. via Hakozaiki Line.

Bus: About 30 min. by bus, About 5 min. by bus, About a 3 min. walk.

Ferry: About 15 min. (Municipal Ferry Service) to Saitozaki, About a 10 min. walk, About 20 min. (Uminaka Line) to Uminonakamichi, About 20 min. (Uminaka Line) to Uminonakamichi.

Car: About 35 min. via Kyushu Expressway Koga Interchange, About 13 min. via Fukuoka Urban Expressway Island City Ramp.

G5 Flower Museum
This lovely garden is divided into 10 areas and was designed to be an 'open-air flower art museum.'

H1 Seaside Hill Shioya
Enjoy a 180-degree panoramic view of the Genkai Sea.

K2 Shiomidai Lookout
This Observation Deck offers stunning views of the Genkai Sea.

This grove of black pine trees was planted to protect against strong sea winds and flying sand from the Genkai Sea.

Q3 SEA DRAGON

Q3 Dog Run
A place to play with your dog off-leash (admission fee charged).
*Dogs must wear their dog registration and rabies vaccination tags.

R4 INN THE PARK FUKUOKA
This unique accommodation option features iconic Dome Tents. The tents are illuminated at night, creating a fantastic magical atmosphere.

X3 Forest Tunnel
Enjoy cycling or taking a leisurely stroll through this serene space surrounded by pine trees and other beautiful nature.

Try a free woodworking workshop.

Here you will find homemade curry, organic coffee and more.

- Fukuoka City "Baby Stations"**
Some of the nursing rooms in the park are designated as "Baby Stations" by Fukuoka City.
- Baby changing tables, baby chairs and nursing rooms are located near main facilities.
 - Feel free to ask for hot water (to warm bottles) at management centers and shops.
 - Free baby strollers are available at all gates.
- Yellow Triangle Flags**
Yellow triangle flags indicate areas that are 7m or higher above sea level, including the Animal Forest Observation Deck (E4), West Gate Management Building (G7), Children's Playground (H5), Outdoor Theater (B3) and Eco-Friendly Forest Observation Deck (T3). We are gradually placing them in other locations as well. Please use these flags as both a landmark and a tsunami evacuation point.

Rental bikes and electric kick scooters are convenient for getting around the park. Wheelchairs, mobility scooters (electric carts) and baby strollers are available free of charge at all gates. Please don't hesitate to ask our staff about them. *Availability is limited.
